## Background

The UCLG Learning Forum meeting is an open space for members, networks, associations and partners to collectively build the future UCLG Learning agenda. It has been built as a place to share learning methodologies, mobilization and capacity building strategies, reflections, needs and solutions.

Three preparatory online stocktaking sessions provided opportunities for members to share their learning offers and alignment to the **UCLG Pact for the Future**, paving the way to Daejeon's Learning Forum. The sessions looked at the topics of peer learning (1), localizing (2) and e-learning (3).

A survey conducted also revealed the need and interest for building skills to embed and facilitate learning into the work routine of LRGs, LRGAs and networks. The input proposals and expectations have also been the base for the UCLG Learning Forum.

## Concept

The Learning Forum gathering in Daejeon is structured in 3 stages:

1.

Leaders and participants strategic dialogue on the usefulness and impact of learning between cities;

2.

Members and partners present opportunities in the Learning Marketplace, a space to showcase and share the best learning experiences, methodologies and games (Learning Arcade);

3.

Experts and focal points: Short masterclasses will provide guidance for learning methodologies, knowledge management, impact studies, pedagogical videos.

We welcome in particular programs that look for networking and partnership, such as awards, methodologies, online offers, platforms, games - members and partners are encouraged to come up with proposals.
